

How does your garden grow?

Try to grow something in your garden, it could be a flower, fruit or vegetable. Keep a diary to show how your plant grows.



Go on a 'bug hunt' in your garden. How many different minibeasts can you find? Write some descriptive sentences about the minibeasts. Try to use at least one adjective in every sentence and try to put a verb and an adverb in your sentence too. E.g. The beautiful blue butterfly fluttered quickly around the small garden.



What are plants used for? Look around your house and see how many things you can find that are made from trees or plants. Draw the things you find and label them. Extra challenge: Can you find out how a few of the things you found were made?



Practise spelling the days of the week and the months of the year, remember they begin with a capital letter.

Can you tell the time? Practise telling the time to quarter past, half past and quarter to the hour on an analogue clock.

Extension: Tell the time to five minute intervals.

Make a minibeast, a flower or a plant using things that you find in your garden. Upload a picture onto Tapstery.



Draw a picture of your garden including flowers etc. and paint some mini beasts using your finger prints.



Minibeast Café Menu
Worm and spider spaghetti 20p

Ladybird burger 12p
Slug slime soup 10p
Butterfly cakes 6p

Add together 3 different items from the list and record using a number sentence (12p + 10p + 6p). Try to buy more than one of each item and then multiply to find the total cost ($4 \times 10p$). Repeat.

Make up your own minibeast menu and record some different number sentences.
