Headteacher Update

School Uniform reminders

Please note that we do expect children to attend in school uniform. The only exception is when they have Forest School sessions when they can come in appropriate clothing for these sessions eg LONG trousers (jogging bottoms or leggings) and a log sleeved top/sweatshirt. Football kits are NOT appropriate. Sweatshirts and cardigans do not need to have the school logo but should be plain red. Girls can wear red and white checked school dresses in the summer.

On Fridays, children should attend in the Fit Friday uniform of white or red T shirt, Fit Friday hoodie, grey or black sports trousers (or shorts as we go into the summer) and trainers.

Please make sure all uniform is named!
