

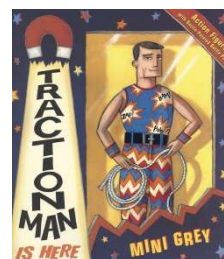
## Newsletter 2– Friday 13th September 2024
