## **December Events**

I know it might still be a little too soon to use the 'C' word but every time I walk into Asda I have a panic at the countdown calendar so I thought I would try to include all the information you will need for December in this newsletter.

### Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> November

This is our **'dress down day'**. On this day children can come to school in non-uniform and all we ask is that they bring a donation/prize for the Christmas Fayre. If you have any unwanted women/men's gifts that could be used for the Secret Santa room or a bottle, jar of sweets, chocolate for the tombolas these would be gratefully received.

### Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December

We would love to see you at our **Bedtime Reading Café** from 5-6.30pm. You and your children are invited to come back to school (in pyjamas and slippers if you wish) and take part in Christmas Craft activities in all the year groups. At 6.15pm the children return to their normal classroom (hall if they are Reception) where we snuggle down for a cosy Christmas bedtime story before going home.



### Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December

Our **Christmas Fayre** will be during the afternoon on this day and for the first time since Covid we are inviting parents/family members to join us again. The fayre will have lots of Christmas games to play in the school hall and Reception class area. There will be a Find the Staff Santas Scavenger Hunt around the building, a Secret Santa room in Owls class – no adults as children are assisted to wrap a gift for a male/female member of their family, a stall selling children's homemade crafts and finally Mrs Claus' kitchen will be open for hot drinks and homemade cakes. In order to make this an enjoyable experience for all we stagger the children's finishing times on this day so there is space to move around the fayre.

Reception children can be collected at 1.45pm, Year One children at 2.15pm and Year Two children at 2.45pm. Once collected the children can then be accompanied around the fayre by their adult(s) and can leave the premises when they are ready. We are aware that not all children will be able to be collected early and after school club arrangements will remain the same. Any children not able to be accompanied by a parent/carer can be sent into school with some money and a staff member will ensure they are able to participate in the fun. Similarly, if you have children in more than one year group you can collect them at the same time.




### Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> December

We will be taking part in our first Federation event with the Junior School and will be participating in **Tapping House's Rudolph Run** on the Junior School field.

Tapping House are a local hospice centre based in Hillington. They offer a variety of services to adults aged 18 and over with life-limiting illnesses, as well as their families and carers. Some of the services they provide are day therapy, home care and bereavement support. All their services are tailored to meet the needs of patients and their families. Although they receive funding from the NHS, they rely heavily on community support and fundraising efforts to sustain their services. As a Federation, we want to support Tapping House and help raise vital funds to allow them to continue supporting the local community.

Before the event, Rudolph will visit our school to drop antlers for each child to wear while they complete the run. **On the day of the event all children need to come to school in their PE kits ready to complete the fun run.** As this event will be taking place during the school day at different times, parents and carers are not able to watch. However, we will take lots of photos and videos to share with you on Tapestry.

Your child will have brought home a sponsorship form today to complete and return to the school office by **Thursday 19**<sup>th</sup> **December.** There is no minimum sponsorship required, all children will be able to take part in this event.



#### Friday 13<sup>th</sup> December

School **Christmas Dinner** day (details will follow) Children can come to school on this day wearing Christmas jumpers/dresses, party outfits whatever they please (bearing in mind they will have playtimes outside).

#### Monday 16<sup>th</sup> December

Year 2 will perform in St Mary's Church at 2pm. Parents/carers are welcome to watch the performance but please be mindful of space and the distraction of younger siblings.

**Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> December** Year 1 will perform in St Mary's Church at 2pm (see above)

#### Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December

Year R will perform in St Mary's Church at 2pm (see above)

All three performances will be professionally recorded during the dress rehearsals and video links will be sent out to you during the Christmas period so you can share them with friends and family. For safeguarding reasons we ask that you do not record the children in Church during their performances please.




In Reception, Fabian and Blossom are now 5 years old In Year 1, In Year 2, Freddy and Olivia are now 7 years old.
