PSHE

Art & Design

English

Later on in the half term the Children will write instructions using the book 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth'.

Science - Materials

We will learn about where materials come from and identify if they are man-made or natural. We will find out about how materials can be recycled, reused and reduced. We will think about how this impacts the wider world.

History
